- Weather: Prepare for the extreme heat and exposure and the possibility of high wind
- **Hiking Distance:** Moderate. Hike up to 2-4 miles on uneven ground, up to 1000' elevation gain or loss and carry up to 2 tools.
- Work Difficulty: Easy to moderate
- Map: BLM Las Cruces Map
- Nearest Town: Hachita, NM (limited services) or Lordsburg NM
- What's Provided: Tools, project materials, work site supervision, qualified 1st aid personnel, safety equipment, snacks and water.
- Food and Water: Light snacks and water provided. Volunteers are responsible for personal lunches.
- What to Bring: Personal gear including: daypack, lunch, sun protection, appropriate clothing, etc.
